Background:	This gene encodes a protein from the glycosyltransferase 32 family. The enzyme catalyzes the transfer of N-acetylglucosamine (GlcNAc) to core 2 branched O-glycans. It forms a unique glycan, GlcNAcα1-→4Galβ-→R and is largely associated with the Golgi apparatus membrane. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008],domain:The conserved DXD motif is involved in enzyme activity.,function:Necessary for the synthesis of type III mucin.
