Background:	This gene encodes a member of the ADAMTS (a disintegrin and metalloproteinase with thrombospondin motifs) protein family. ADAMTS family members share several distinct protein modules, including a propeptide region, a metalloproteinase domain, a disintegrin-like domain, and a thrombospondin type 1 (TS) motif. Individual members of this family differ in the number of C-terminal TS motifs, and some have unique C-terminal domains. The encoded preproprotein is proteolytically processed to generate the mature protein, which may regulate hemostatic balance and function as a tumor suppressor. Mutations in this gene may be associated with microcornea, myopic chorioretinal atrophy, and telecanthus (MMCAT) and cone-rod dystrophy in human patients. [provided by RefSeq, May 2016],cofactor: Binds 1 zinc ion per subunit.,domain: The conserved cysteine present in the cysteine-switch motif binds the catalytic zinc ion, thus inhibiting the enzyme. The dissociation of the cysteine from the zinc ion upon the activation-peptide release activates the enzyme.,PTM: The precursor is cleaved by a furin endopeptidase.,similarity: Contains 1 disintegrin domain.,similarity: Contains 1 peptidase M12B domain.,similarity: Contains 1 PLAC domain.,similarity: Contains 5 TSP type-1 domains.,tissue specificity: Expressed in fetal lung, liver, and kidney and in adult brain, prostate, submaxillary gland, and endothelium.,
