Beta-3 is involved in the regulation of lipolysis and thermogenesis.,polymorphism:The variant Arg-64 seems to be associated with weight gain (obesity) and to is also associated with susceptibility to non-insulin-dependent diabetes mellitus (NIDDM).,similarity:Belongs to the G-protein coupled receptor 1 family.,tissue specificity:Expressed mainly in adipose tissues.,
