Several transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Oct 2011],catalytic activity:ATP + a protein = ADP + a phosphoprotein.,function:Involved in the specific phosphorylation of microtubule-associated proteins for tau, MAP2 and MAP4.
