Background:	The protein encoded by this gene is a lysosomal cysteine proteinase and member of the peptidase C1 family. It exhibits both carboxy-monopeptidase and carboxy-dipeptidase activities. The encoded protein has also been known as cathepsin X and cathepsin P. This gene is expressed ubiquitously in cancer cell lines and primary tumors and, like other members of this family, may be involved in tumorigenesis. Shows weak endopeptidase activity.,function:Exhibits carboxy-monopeptidase as well as carboxy-dipeptidase activity.,similarity:Belongs to the peptidase C1 family.,tissue specificity:Widely expressed.,
