Background:	The protein encoded by this gene is a member of the G protein-coupled receptor family. This protein is one of four receptors identified for prostaglandin E2 (PGE2). Through a phosphatidylinositol-calcium second messenger system, G-Q proteins mediate this receptor's activity. Knockout studies in mice suggested a role of this receptor in mediating algnesia and in regulation of blood pressure. Studies in mice also suggested that this gene may mediate adrenocorticotrophic hormone response to bacterial endotoxin. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008],function:Receptor for prostaglandin E2 (PGE2). The activity of this receptor is mediated by G(q) proteins which activate a phosphatidylinositol-calcium second messenger system. May play a role as an important modulator of renal function. Implicated the smooth muscle contractile response to PGE2 in various tissues.,PTM:Phosphorylated .,similarity:Belongs to the G-protein coupled receptor 1 family.,tissue specificity:Abundant in kidney. Lower level expression in lung, skeletal muscle and spleen, lowest expression in testis and not detected in liver brain and heart.,
