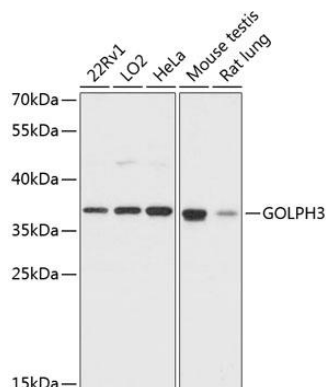
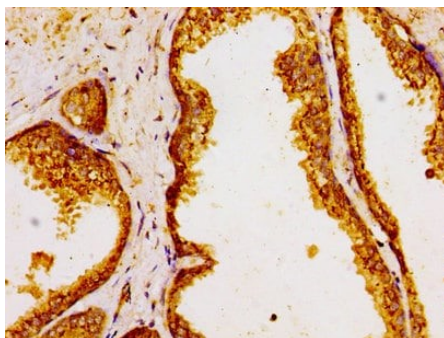


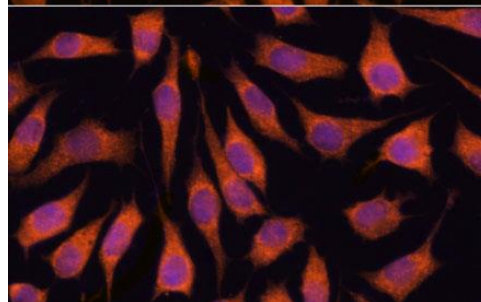
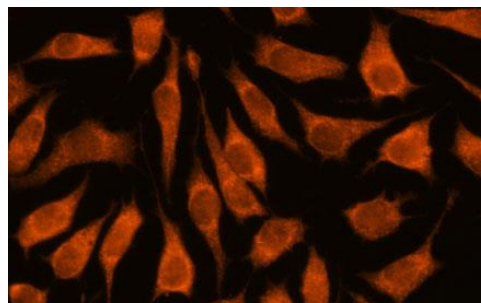

Background:	The Golgi complex plays a key role in the sorting and modification of proteins exported from the endoplasmic reticulum. The protein encoded by this gene is a peripheral membrane protein of the Golgi stack and may have a regulatory role in Golgi trafficking. Several alternatively spliced transcript variants of this gene have been described, but the full-length nature of these variants has not been determined.



Western blot analysis of extracts of various cell lines, using GOLPH3 antibody at 1:3000 dilution. Secondary antibody: HRP Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L) at 1:10000 dilution. Lysates/proteins: 25ug per lane. Blocking buffer: 3% nonfat dry milk in TBST. Detection: ECL West Pico Plus. Exposure time: 15s.



Immunohistochemistry Paraffin-embedded human prostate cancer tissue stained for GOLPH3/MIDAS using at 1:100 dilution in immunohistochemical analysis.



Immunofluorescence analysis of L929 cells using GOLPH3 antibody at dilution of 1:100. Blue: DAPI for nuclear staining.
