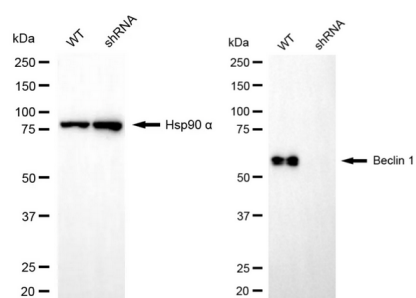
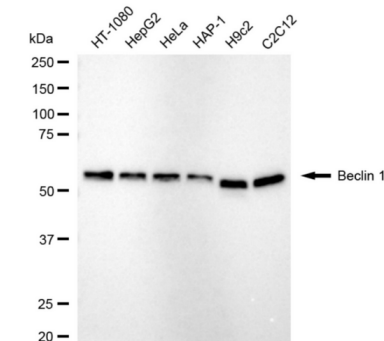

Background: This gene encodes a protein that regulates autophagy, a catabolic process of degradation induced by starvation. The encoded protein is a component of the phosphatidylinositol-3-kinase (PI3K) complex which mediates vesicle-trafficking processes. This protein is thought to play a role in multiple cellular processes, including tumorigenesis, neurodegeneration and apoptosis. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants.



Western blot analysis using beclin 1 antibody. Total cell lysates (30 µg) from various cell lines were loaded and separated by SDS-PAGE. The blot was incubated with beclin 1 antibody (1:5,000) and HRP-conjugated goat anti-rabbit secondary antibody (1:10,000) respectively.



Validation of Beclin 1 knockdown using flow cytometry. Wild-type(WT, Blue) and knockdown(KD, Green) HeLa cells were stained with Beclin 1 antibody (1:2,000) and analyzed using BD flow cytometer.
