Background:	The protein encoded by this gene is a membrane-bound receptor and member of the melanocortin receptor family. The encoded protein interacts with adrenocorticotrophic and MSH hormones and is mediated by G proteins. This is an intronless gene. Defects in this gene are a cause of autosomal dominant obesity. [provided by RefSeq, Jan 2010],disease:Defects in MC4R are a cause of autosomal dominant obesity [MIM:601665],function:Receptor specific to the heptapeptide core common to adrenocorticotrophic hormone and alpha-, beta-, and gamma-MSH.
