Background:	This gene encodes a member of the protease-activated receptor (PAR) family which is a subfamily of the seven transmembrane G protein-coupled cell surface receptor family. The encoded protein acts as a cofactor in the thrombin-mediated cleavage and activation of the protease-activated receptor family member PAR4. The encoded protein plays an essential role in hemostasis and thrombosis. Alternate splicing results in multiple transcript variants that encode different isoforms. [provided by RefSeq, Feb 2012],function:Receptor for activated thrombin coupled to G proteins that stimulate phosphoinositide hydrolysis.,PTM:A proteolytic cleavage generates a new N-terminus that functions as a tethered ligand.,similarity:Belongs to the G-protein coupled receptor 1 family.,subunit:Interacts with INSC/inscuteable and probably GPSM2.,tissue specificity:Highest expression in the megakaryocytes of the bone marrow, lower in mature megakaryocytes, in platelets and in a variety of other tissues such as heart and gut.,
