Background:	Cdk2 is a member of the Ser/Thr protein kinase family. It is highly similar to the gene products of <i>S. cerevisiae</i> cdc28, and <i>S. pombe</i> cdc2. Cdk2 is closely related to cdc2 (cdk1) which has proved useful as a marker of proliferation. Cdk1 and Cdk2 are a catalytic subunits of the highly conserved protein kinase complex known as M-phase promoting factor (MPF), which is essential for G1/S and G2/M phase transitions of eukaryotic cell cycle.
