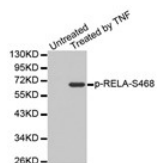
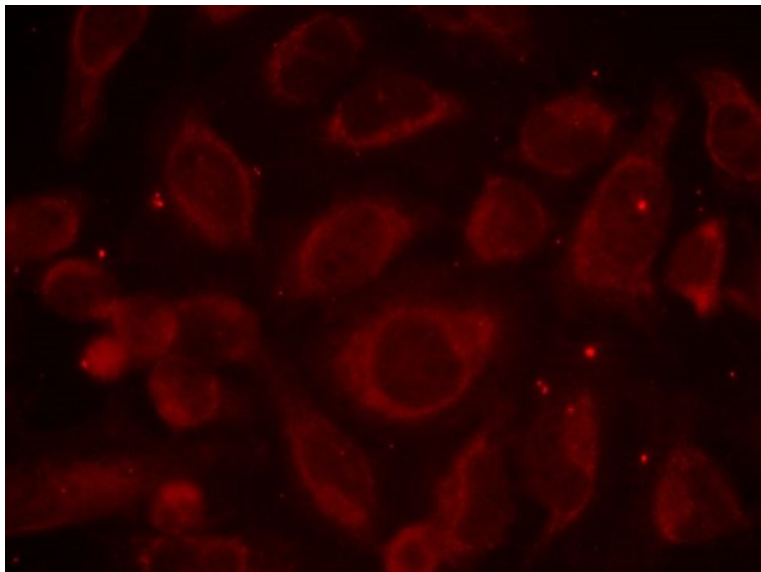

Background:	NF-kappa-B is a ubiquitous transcription factor involved in several biological processes. It is held in the cytoplasm in an inactive state by specific inhibitors. Upon degradation of the inhibitor, NF-kappa-B moves to the nucleus and activates transcription of specific genes. NF-kappa-B is composed of NFκB1 or NFκB2 bound to either REL, NFκB-P65, or RELB. The most abundant form of NF-kappa-B is NFκB1 complexed with the product of this gene, NFκB-P65. Four transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene.
